The Fourteenth Sunday of the Year

Father Paul writes.....

Our Old Testament reading this Sunday is from the Prophet Ezekiel who was born in about 623 before Christ. He was a priest as well and was in exile along with the people from Israel who had been deported to Babylon. The reading describes the call of Ezekiel by the Lord, and his task was to proclaim the Word of God. In other words, he was to tell the people how God saw things because the work of a prophet was to see the world and events in the same way.

His people, to whom he had to announce a message of change and repentance, were 'defiant and obstinate'; they were 'hard-hearted'. He was unlikely to receive a sympathetic hearing as the Lord indicated when he said, "Whether they listen or not this set of rebels shall know there is a prophet among them".

Ezekiel and all the prophets often proclaimed a message that people did not want to hear because it invited them to change and to conversion. The minds of their hearers were closed, or they somehow did not catch the significance of the message for them. How often is that true of us? How often do we resist truths that prompt us to change our ways? How often are we afraid of 'prophetic messages' that uncover aspects of ourselves with which we are uncomfortable, and which we need to change?

Ezekiel experienced resistance to his message as did Jesus. We see and hear Jesus today in the synagogue in his hometown of Nazareth. The people knew him and had known him since childhood. They knew he was a carpenter and knew his brothers and sisters, which was a way of describing his cousins and close relatives. They knew his reputation as one who taught, worked miracles and yet they would not accept him. They knew him too well and he was too familiar. Like Ezekiel, they could not accept him or his prophetic, in fact divine, message.

The challenge to change or the invitation to hear God's invitation speaking in our hearts, more often than not, comes in the familiar and day to day, in the ordinariness of life. We are invited to treasure the ordinary and familiar and the immediacy of relationships because God became human in Jesus, and it is our humanity in its ordinariness which connects us with God and all that is holy. As St. Irenaeus said, "The glory of God is women and men fully alive".
