The Thirty Third Sunday of the Year Father Paul writes....

Our readings this weekend, and for the next few weeks, invite us to reflect in prayer on the journey and process in which creation and humanity is involved. The Gospel this Sunday, considers the moment in the history of creation when "the sun will be darkened" and everything, including us, will find completion and fulfilment in the life and joy of God.

The term often used for what St. Mark and I are trying to describe is the 'end of the world' but that term is misleading and not too helpful. The Gospel narrative describes cosmic events, using poetic images, which indicate a huge change in creation as we know it. But it is a change and not an end. A change which has already begun in the death and resurrection of Jesus. In his description of Jesus's death, St. Mark tells us that "there was darkness over the whole land, when the sun's light failed". The life, death and resurrection of Jesus marked that major change that will culminate in the completion and perfection of creation and humanity in the life of God. It is not something we can begin to imagine, so perhaps we should not try. Our task, instead, is to prepare for the Second Coming of Christ by living in love, respecting the gift of creation and working for unity and peace between human beings.

The New Translation: Our readings this week and next, the Solemnity of Christ the King, prepare us for the First Sunday of Advent on the 1st December. On that day, we shall hear Luke's version of the event which Mark describes today. The readings will be proclaimed using the Lectionary which provides a new translation of the scripture. The translation is called the English Standard Version which the bishops of England and Wales have decided is the best translation for us.
