# Fourth Sunday of Advent

Father Paul writes....

I am writing this thought in my room at Quarr Abbey. I make a two-day visit here every two months or so. I have experimented with different ways of getting to the Isle of Wight. Today, I parked the car at St. Swithun's in Southsea – where Fr. Anthony Fyk is the Parish Priest and walked to the ferry at Portsmouth Gunwarfe.

The journey and the arrival at Quarr Abbey were two experiences of extreme contrast. The ferry was full of children anticipating the festivities of Christmas – I am writing this on the 15<sup>th</sup> of December. I overheard songs, and children looking forward to parties, presents and visits to Fr. Christmas or his visit to them.

Then I arrived at Quarr as Vespers (Evening Prayer) began. The chanting of the psalms, Exposition and Benediction, with clouds of incense produced a powerful atmosphere of prayer, contemplation interspersed with community silence.

As I wish everyone a Happy Christmas, I hope it will be one full of song, entertainment, and jollification as well as being a time for prayer, contemplation of the mystery of the Incarnation, the Word of God made flesh.

Thanks to everyone for your kindness and generosity to me over Christmas, I am immensely grateful.
