The Third Sunday of the Year

Father Paul writes.....

During this year, our Gospel readings are taken from the Gospel of St. Luke. His Gospel is written in two parts, the Gospel itself from which we hear today and the second volume which is called the Acts of the Apostles. The Gospel presents the events of the birth, life, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus. The Acts of the Apostles describes the beginning of the Church and the action of the Holy Spirit in the lives of the Lord's disciples.



Today's narrative sees Jesus launching into his 'public ministry'. The location is the synagogue in his hometown of Nazareth where Jesus reads from the Prophet Isaiah. The quotation Jesus uses looks to the moment in history when the anointed one will come from God with the gifts of liberation, freedom and release from restrictions to human freedom. Isaiah describes the event as 'good-news' because it is about the peace and restoration that God gives.

To the amazement of the people in the synagogue Jesus ended by saying "Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing".

The gift of the Holy Spirit to us now means that the fulfilment of which Jesus speaks is happening in our lives. Do we recognise the signs of that fulfilment in our lives? Do we cooperate with the Holy Spirit in our faith, hope and love?

Isaiah would have agreed with the words of Bishop Budde of Washington this week: "I ask you to have mercy, on those in our communities whose children fear that their parents will be taken away, and that you help those who are fleeing war zones and persecution in their own lands to find compassion and welcome here. Our God teaches us that we are to be merciful to the stranger, for we were all once strangers in this land."

Second Collection Cathedral of St. John, Mother Church of the Diocese

Canon James McAuley, Dean of the Cathedral, Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia writes:

Since I became Dean of our Cathedral Church of St John the Evangelist in September 2022, the parish has had to pay for the emergency repair of three serious roof leaks, as well as the replacement of two failing flat roofs. The cost of these repairs was met from parish funds. In 2023, the 120-year-old West Window had to be shored up, removed and completely restored to prevent its imminent collapse. So far, generous donors from the parish and from across the diocese have contributed £84,130 of the £90.100 cost of repair.

Our most recent quinquennial architectural survey (autumn 2023) indicated work required over the next few years to the roof, windows, heating, and electrical systems at an estimated cost of £2 million plus VAT.

I fully appreciate the financial pressures being felt by you and by your fellow parishioners but would appeal to you to support the Second Collection for the Cathedral on 26th January. Never has this annual collection by parishes for the Mother Church of the Diocese been more critical or needed. Your support is vitally important to us.
