The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple

Father Paul writes.....

Today's feast is always celebrated on the 2nd February. Because it is a feast of the Lord Jesus it always takes the place of the ordinary prayers and readings when the 2nd February falls on a Sunday. The location for today's Gospel narrative from St. Luke is the Temple in Jerusalem. The significance of the Temple for the people of Israel and for our appreciation of the Gospels cannot be overemphasized.

The first Temple was built by King Solomon following the wish of his father King David. It was built 900 years or so

before Jesus and destroyed in 587BC during the Babylonian siege of Jerusalem. It housed the 'Ark of the Covenant' which is said to have contained the tablets of the Ten Commandments.

Another Temple was built on the same site, the 'Temple Mount', after the Persian conquest of Babylon, in around 516 BC. Much later, at the beginning of the 1st century AD this temple was refurbished by King Herod the Great, to a magnificent degree. It was a 'wonder of the then world'. Visitors to Jerusalem would be able to see the beautiful model. There is only a model because Herod's temple was destroyed in 70 AD by the Romans who built it in the first place. The Temple became the place where, it was believed, God dwelt on earth. When Jesus was presented in the Temple, God had truly entered the Temple.

Many Jewish people believe that God still dwells on the Temple Mount. The 'Western' or 'Wailing' wall in Jerusalem is the last remaining wall of the Temple and Jewish men and women come to pray there because it is viewed as so sacred.

Our Celebration of Mass this weekend, will begin with the procession of lighted candles. This act of worship proclaims that Jesus is the light of the nations, as Simeon also proclaimed in his prayer which we call, in Latin, the 'Nunc Dimittis'.
