The Fifth Sunday of the Year Father Paul writes.....

I am grateful to our 'Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion' and their coordinators in our two parishes. With the generous gift of their time, they help with the distribution of Holy Communion both at Mass and by taking Holy Communion to the sick and housebound who are unable to come to Mass. This is a crucial ministry in all parishes.

With their help we have been able to reintroduce Holy Communion from the chalice. At our Masses on Sunday and on some weekdays, as well as receiving the 'Body of Christ' there will now be the option of receiving the 'Blood of Christ' from the chalice. It is sufficient to receive Holy Communion either as the Body of Christ or as the Blood of Christ. While everyone has a right to receive both the Body of Christ and the Blood of Christ, to receive one without the other is entirely acceptable because we receive the fullness of the risen Lord in either kind. To be clear, we do not have to receive the Blood of Christ from the chalice, only the priest must do that.

If you think you have a cold or that influenza is on its way, please refrain from receiving the Blood of Christ or the 'Precious Blood' as it is also called.

The Church provides guidelines on the reception of Holy Communion, which I will include here for information:

We are invited to bow or genuflect before receiving Holy Communion. Those who wish may also kneel before receiving Communion. This applies to the Body of Christ and the Precious Blood.

The priest or minster will hold the Body of the Lord or the chalice so that we can look at it in faith and he will say "The Body/Blood of Christ" to which our response is "Amen".

We may receive the Body of the Lord either on the tongue or in the hand. Those who, receive in the hand must consume the 'host', as the Body of Christ is called, within sight of the priest.

To receive the Precious Blood from the chalice, take the chalice in both hands and take a sip.

We are not permitted to practice 'intinction'. This involves taking the Body of Christ to the chalice and dipping it before consumption.

Anyone who is not receiving Holy Communion may come forward for a blessing. To indicate that wish simply fold arms across the chest in the form of a cross.
