Keeping you informed

From the Joint Parish Finance Committee

Last financial year 2021-2022 our parishes operated at a small deficit. This is because we were waiting for the Diocese to complete our last quarter gift aid. This was received too late to include in the 21-22 figures.

Our goal last year was to increase our giving to cover our basic costs, and then to build reserves of cir £50,000 (approximately 50% of our annual running costs). This reserve was required so that we could meet any expenses resulting from the Diocesan quinquennial report due in 2021. We continue to maintain these reserves even after major projects such as a new boiler in Ringwood and the complete refurbishment of the in the Ringwood flat.


Our regular running costs are likely to increase this coming financial year and we should not become complacent. We continue to look very closely at all our expenditure across the two parishes to gain cost savings and increased efficiency.


