

A GOOD TIME TO REMIND PEOPLE... CAR PARKING FOR CHRISTMAS SERVICES ONLY

The following is the situation over Christmas.

At Priory Vets (next door):

we may park at the front of the surgery, using the 8 spaces,

At Harbour House (opposite the Vets):
